Regulations «30th Maximaphily Day»

1.

The "30th Maximaphily Day" of the FSPL will take place within MAMER 2019. Participation is open to:

- members affiliated with the FSPL associations;
- collectors from abroad invited by the organizer.

2.

The responsible organizer is the Cercle Philatélique de Mamer, member of the FSPL (Fédération des Sociétés Philatéliques du Grand Duché de Luxembourg), together with the "Commission de Maximaphilie" of the FSPL.

3.

The exhibition is written out for maximaphily collections, competition and no competition.

4.

The exhibition takes place in Mamer/Luxembourg, from Saturday, October 12th until Sunday, October 13th 2019 included.

5.

The registrations on the special entry form have to be sent up to May 1st 2019 directly to the exhibition director, Ralph LETSCH, 2 rue Spierzelt, L-8063 Bertrange (or rletsch@pt.lu).

6.

Exhibitors will be selected by the organizer until June 1st 2019. A collection inscribed in the competition class must have 4 (four) or 5 (five) frames (1 frame = 15 sheets) or be a "1 frame" collection. A pre-award for admission to the exhibition is not required. The collections out of competition comprise 1 (one) or 2 (two) frames (always 2 for the invitees).

7.

The maximaphily collections in the competition are evaluated according to the relevant FIP regulations. The other collections are not rated.

8.

Each exhibitor receives a certificate of participation and a non-cash prize from the organizer. The exhibitors in the competition receive the diploma of FSPL issued in the rank of the medal awarded.

9.

Only sheets which are to be exposed can be accepted. Each sheet must be provided with a transparent sleeve.

10.

No writing and participation fee are levied.

11.

The exhibitor himself ensures that his exhibit is brought in time for the exhibition and set up. The exhibitor is also obliged to take back the exhibit after the end of the exhibition; on request, the dismantling and the delivery by post to the exhibitor is done by the organizer by pre-paid contribution of EUR 30, -.

12.

The exhibitors themselves have to take care of all risks in order to insure their collection. The organizer provides for the best possible protection of the collections, but rejects any responsibility for loss, damage and theft; either in part or in full, during the transportation, the construction, the duration of the exhibition and the dismantling of the collections.

13.

In all cases, which are not foreseen by the present regulation, the organisation executive committee decides.

14.

The signature of the exhibitor on the special entry form for registration means the recognition and the observance of these regulations.
