



Code of conduct of the Ice Hockey club Huskies

This code of conduct established by the ice hockey club Huskies applies to all players, parents, coaches, off-ices, team managers and board members if they participate in an activity of the club.

- I will be a worthy ambassador of the sport and I will have an impeccable and respectful attitude when I represent the club of the Huskies.
- I will respect IIHF (International Ice Hockey Federation) rules and always wear my mandatory equipment on the ice.
- I pledge to support and participate in the life of the club.
- I will train and practice Ice Hockey with a good spirit, without intent to abuse or hurt others.
- I will encourage and privilege team spirit and respect my opponent in all circumstances.
- I will respect the rules and decisions of my club, referees and those of the Ice Hockey League.
- I will trust coaches and stay at my place as a player or parent watching during games or training.
- I will not encourage any comment or gesture about racism or any other form of discrimination.
- I will not participate in or encourage any form of harassment. I will report everything immediately to a member of the committee / head coach.
- I will be a good teammate and will support my coach and my teammates, even the weakest ones.
- I will leave the changing rooms and rinks borrowed in the same state in which they will have been made available.
- I will not intentionally degrade club equipment, the rink or any other facility.
- When traveling as part of the championship, I commit to travelling by bus and staying at the hotel with my team.
- I will not consume alcohol, tobacco, drugs in the locker room, ice rink and bus when representing the Huskies.
- I will always adopt an attitude and a vocabulary adapted and respectful of the people around me.
- I will inform the coach and / or team leader if I cannot participate in training or games. The start time of the training corresponds to the start time of the training on ice. It is therefore essential to allow enough time to prepare in order to be ready at the indicated time. Coaches have the right to refuse access to the ice in case of repeated and unjustified lateness. It is forbidden to go on the ice without the presence and approval of the coach.



Code of conduct of the Ice Hockey club Huskies

- I will be responsible for my actions, on and off the ice.
- I will have the appropriate equipment for ice hockey.
- My parents and other persons will not be allowed to attend practices but will only be allowed in the rink during games.
- It is strictly forbidden for parents to interfere with the coaches and players while they are on the ice.
- In case of improper behavior, my parents and I know that a temporary or permanent exclusion from the club may be the consequence.
- I am with my parents personally responsible for financial penalties or sanctions that could be attributed to me by the Luxembourg Federation, or the French Hockey Federation, due to my mistakes or misbehavior during games. Any failure to pay these penalties will result in my temporarily or permanently exclusion from club activities.

I (player, legal guardian) certify having read and understood this code of conduct and agree to respect it. I acknowledge the right of the Huskies Ice Hockey Club to sanction any behavior contrary to the rules set out if it were necessary, up to a temporary or definitive exclusion from the club.
